HISTORIC EUROREGION SIRET-PRUT-NISTRU

The cross-border cooperation within the European Union and the candidate countries has gradually evolved from addressing common issues and socio-cultural cooperation to developing common strategies to exploit the common potential. Subsequently, the cooperation was developed at project level to include the preparation and implementation of EU programs supporting cross-border cooperation in the member states.

The regulations and guidelines of European Union have imposed the existence a necessary structure for the development of cross-border programs and for the management of the implementation of these programs.

The legislative framework for carrying out cross-border cooperation actions by the authorities and local communities from Romania is ensured by Government Emergency Ordinance (GEO) no. 120/1998 for the ratification by Romania of the *European Framework Convention on Cross-Border Cooperation of Communities or Authorities*, Adopted in Madrid on 21 May 1980. Romania is a party to the European Charter of Local Self-Government, adopted in Strasbourg on October 15, 1985, and ratified by the Law 199/1997.

According to the provisions of the Madrid Convention, cross-border cooperation aims to strengthen and develop neighborhood relations between communities or territorial authorities that are dependent on two or more Contracting Parties, as well as the conclusion of agreements and understandings that are useful for this purpose.

The Euroregion Siret – Prut – Nistru is a permanent structure with its own identity. It was established on 18 September 2002 to facilitate the cooperation between three counties in ROMANIA (IAŞI, NEAMŢ AND VASLUI) and initially three counties of REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA (UNGHENI, LAPUŞNA AND CHISINAU), on 4 December 2002 the same year other 3 counties joined: ORHEI and SOROCA (REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA). Thus, the signing of the Cross - border Cooperation Protocol of the Siret - Prut - Nistru Euroregion was held in lasi on 18 September 2002, while the Statute of the Siret - Prut - Nistru Euroregion was adopted in the first Forum of Euroregion Presidents on 4 December 2002 in Ungheni, Republic of Moldova.

As a result of the administrative-territorial reorganization in 2003, the Republic of Moldova resulted in 18 member raions of the Euroregion: Anenii Noi, Basarabeasca, Calarasi, Cimislia, Criuleni, Dubasari, Floresti, Hancesti, Ialoveni, Leova, Nisporeni, Orhei, Straseni, Soldanesti, Telenesti and Ungheni.

ADMINISTRATIVE STRUCTURE

FORUM OF PRESIDENTS – "The Council of Legal Representatives of the administrative-territorial units - the Forum of Presidents - consists of the Presidents of the administrative-territorial units of the counties and districts of the Euroregion ..." (Article 2 of the Statute of the Euroregion)

"The Presidents' Forum adopts its resolutions and decisions by open vote. Resolutions and decisions are adopted by consensus of the participants with the right to vote "(Article 5 of the Statute of the Euroregion)





Working methods of Siret - Prut - Nistru Euroregion:

- development and cooperation does not require measures based on individual cases;
- it is constituted the solid base for initiating, maintaining and developing cross-border relations: citizens, institutions, politicians, social partners, etc.
- implementation of cross-border decisions at national level, in accordance with procedures applicable on both sides of the border (avoiding conflicts of competencies and structural capacities);
- cooperarea se face pe plan orizontal, în afara graniței și în plan vertical (european, guvernamental, regional și local).
- the cooperation is done horizontally, across borders and in vertical (European, governmental, regional and local).

Activities carried out within the euroregion:

- the annual organization of conferences, symposiums, international and scientific meetings on cross-border cooperation issues;
- exchange of experience in the administrative area, cultural, socio economic, etc.;
- identifying and preparing the steps for the joint projects of the euroregion;
- numerous actions in the cultural and scientific field:
- building partnerships in the metropolitan development.

The **S**iret – **P**rut – **N**istru **Euroregion** enjoys the logistical support of the first Euroregion established in the European Union in 1952, EUREGIO.

HISTORIC ASSOCIATION EUROREGION SIRET-PRUT-NISTRU

By the Romania Government Ordinance no. 120/1998 for the ratification by Romania of the European Framework Convention on Cross-border Cooperation of Local Communities or Authorities, adopted in Madrid on May 21, 1980, with subsequent amendments and amendments, mentions the activities of the Euroregions without the legislator establishing their capacity to be a holder of rights and obligations with national or international character. In order to benefit from all these rights and obligations and to access various funds, the **S**iret - **P**rut - **N**istru **Euroregion** found the way to acquire legal personality through the establishment of an association.

In May 2005, the **S**iret - **P**rut - **N**istru **Euroregion** with the support of the lasi County Council established the "**S**iret - **P**rut - **N**istru **Euroregion**" Association, through which it has the possibility to manage its own funds. An important objective of the association is the absorption of funds for the implementation of cross-border projects.

The association reunited in May 2005 as founding members, the 20 members of the Euroregion: Iaşi County, Vaslui County, Romania, Anenii Noi District, Basarabeasca District, Călăraşi District, Cimislia District, Criuleni District, Dubăsari District, Floreşti District, Hancesti District, Ialoveni District, Leova District, Nisporeni District, Orhei District, Rezina District, Soroca District, Straseni District, Şoldăneşti District, Telenesti District, Ungheni District, Republic of Moldova.







At 1 september 2015, the Euroregion "Siret-Prut-Nistru" and Association "Euroregion Siret – Prut – Nistru" brings together 25 districts of 32 from the Republic of Moldova, Balti Municipality, Gagauzia Autonomous Territorial Unit and 3 counties from Romania (IASI, PRAHOVA AND VASLUI).

MAJOR LANDMARKS

The Association Euroregion Siret-Prut-Nistru brings together **25 districts** of 32 from the **Republic of Moldova**, **Balti Municipality**, **Gagauzia** Autonomous Territorial Unit and 3 counties from **Romania** (IASI, PRAHOVA AND VASLUI). It was established in 2005, as a Romanian legal person, based in Iaşi. Pe baza relaţiilor bune stabilite în Ucraina în noiembrie 2012, Euroregiunea Siret-Prut-Nistru a semnat un acord de cooperare cu Euroregiunea Nistru, care include regiunea Vinitsa (Ucraina) şi 7 raioane de pe graniţa nordică şi nord-estă a Republicii Moldova.

The mission of the association is part of the European Union's Convergence Objective, stating that it is aimed at a cross-border level (with three local governments in the European Union and 26 local administrations outside the European Union).

Mission of the association

Extend and improve the relations between local communities and authorities in the economic, cultural, scientific and civic sphere, in order to ensure the sustainable and balanced territorial development of the Euroregion.

Respecting, protecting and guaranteeing the rights and interests of the administrative-territorial units belonging to the Siret-Prut-Nistru Euroregion.

The activities and projects of the association cover various areas of interest, from economy, infrastructure, environmental protection, tourism, agriculture and rural development, human resources development and social services to education, information society and culture, in line with the development strategies of the local administrations.

The Transfrontier Economic Forum represents the manifestation of the mission undertaken by the Iasi County Council and the Siret-Prut-Nistru Euroregion to support the development of cross-border economic relations at the eastern border of the European Union







Over 200 companies from 23 administrative areas belonging to the Siret-Prut-Nistru Euroregion,













representing the districts of the Republic of Moldova, Vinnytsia, Odessa, Chernivtsy, Ivano-Frankivsk (Ukraine) and 6 counties in the North- East (Romania), who had the opportunity to exhibit their products, to present their activity and to interact directly.

The second day of the event was dedicated to the large companies and large-scale projects of local governments. There were presented the most important projects supported by the lasi County Council, the Administrations of Vinnytsia and Chernivtsi and by the Bacau Chamber of Commerce. Large companies like Valrom Industries, MPP Ruslana and UKR PRO INVEST (Ukraine) and EximBank, Antibiotice lasi, Fortus, Hydramold, Brikstone (Romania) have expressed interest in developing cross-border collaborations.

The event captured the media interest in Romania and Ukraine, being related by 32 partners from the local and national media and 40 Ukrainian radio and television journalists.

General objective


Formation of local pillars in project management in the Republic of Moldova. For this purpose, within the project, a training course is organized for the training of cultural experts as project managers, delegated by each Council member of the "Siret-Prut-Nistru Euroregion" Association. At the same time, the participants are informed about the common elements of tradition, between Romania and the Republic of Moldova, based on the cultural objectives of the city of lasi.





The course included ways of identifying sources of funding, how to prepare a grant application, the basics of a project, and the process of project implementation / management. The training was completed with the student evaluation stage and handing over the CNFPA accredited diplomas for the project manager. The training sessions took place in lasi, between 26.08.2013 - 30.08.2013.

The end of the project "Cultural Management - Framework for Preserving the Traditional Values in the Republic of Moldova" was created by the joint elaboration by the trained persons of 5 projects for promoting the values and traditional elements of the Republic of Moldova.



Each of the five projects developed and presented during the training sessions will be monitored by the AESPN after the completion of the internship to provide logistical support to applicants in raising funds. Also, the 5 projects are **published on the website** created within the project funded by the MAE - DPRRP.
