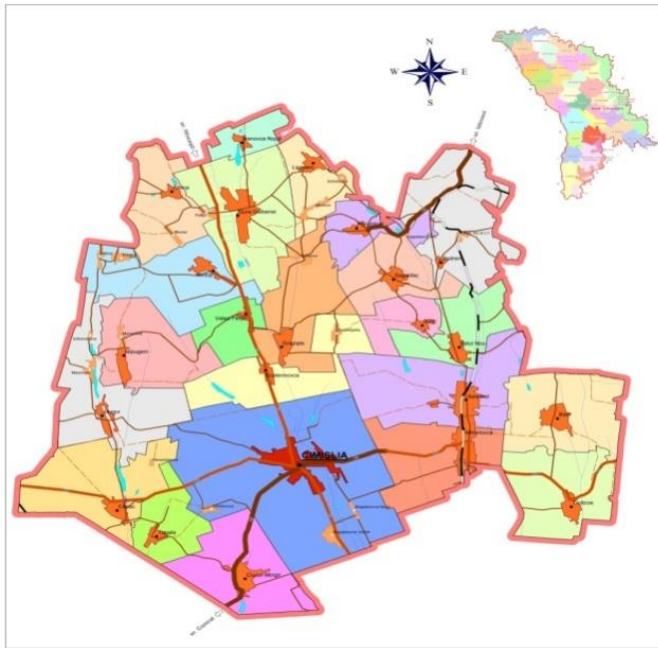




Background

Cimislia is located in the southern part of Moldova. It is located 73 km from the capital, Chişinău, at the intersection of several of the country's more important roads: it is on the route from Chişinău to Bolgrad or Giurgiuleşti, and is also on the Tiraspol – Leova road. It is 30 km from Comrat, 57 km from Căuşeni, 35 km from Hînceşti, 28 km from Basarabeasca, and 52 km from Leova.

District basis date: November 11, 1940
It consists of: 1 town, 38 villages
divided into 23 administrative territorial
units.





NATURE

The total area of the district: 92 370 ha
71 124 ha are agricultural land, including:
Arable land - 51 247 ha;
Perennial plantings - 8741 ha;
Pastures - 11 136 ha;
Forest plantations - 12 952 ha;
Forest land - 11 535 ha;
Forest vegetation - 1417 ha.

Creditworthiness is 62 degree average soil / ha.

UTA reserve fund - 15635.33 ha.

The local roads in the district have a length of 177 km, of which 153 km are hard cover.



POPULATION

District population is 58 400 people, including:
urban population - 14 800 people and the rural population - 43 600
people, of which:

0-2 years – 1266 children;
3-4 years – 1010 children;
5-6 years – 1013 children;
7-10 years - 2395 children;
11-15 years - 3805 children.

In the district there are 764 families with three or more children.

The population density is 63 people / 1km.

The number of households is 21 058.







Economy and agriculture in the district

Agriculture is the main branch of socio-economic development of the district.

On January 1, 2015 in the district were recorded 1249 enterprises (98% are small and medium enterprises), of which:

- Peasant households - 11216 ;
- Joint-stock company- 31;
- Individual businesses - 1249;
- Limited Liability Companies-534;
- 261 persons engaged in entrepreneurial activities under patent

The main grain crops which plants in the district are: wheat, maize, barley, rye and technical crops - sunflower, rape.





THE INDUSTRY

**District industry is represented by
68 industrial companies,
including:**

- 8 wineries;
- 2 poultry farm
- 25 gristmills;
- 1 elevator ;
- 3 bakeries;
- 4 enterprises producing sausage
and meat products;
- 1 brewery;
- 2 fruit dryer companies;
- 1 furniture factory;
- 1 company producing agricultural
machinery.

In the district there are 39 kindergarden, 7 primary schools, 16 middle schools, four high schools.

The festival aims to promote Moldovan folk dance traditions and customs area.

7. The festival traditions habits „Song, dance and mirth as in our village" - aim at preserving national customs, promoting rural tourism and cultural tradition.

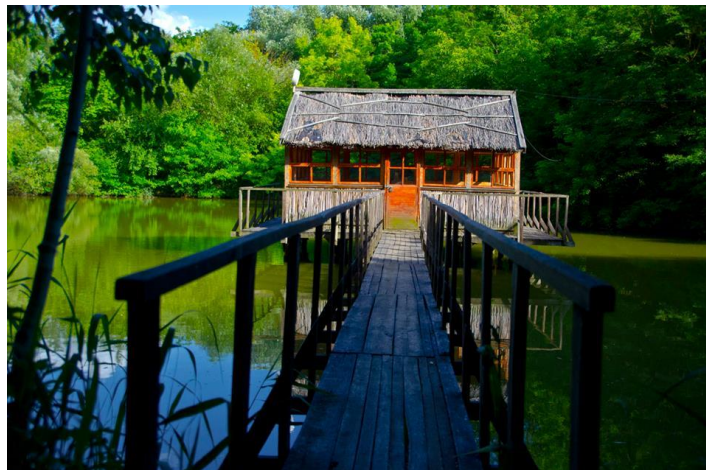
